Legally Authorized Person

Florida Funeral Statutes Chapter 497
FUNERAL, CEMETERY, AND CONSUMER SERVICES

Where there is a person in any priority class listed in this subsection, the funeral establishment shall rely upon the authorization of any one legally authorized person of that class if that person represents that she or he is not aware of any objection to the cremation of the deceased's human remains by others in the same class of the person making the representation or of any person in a higher priority class.

497.005 Definitions. (43) "Legally authorized person" means, in the priority listed:

- (a) The decedent, when written inter vivos authorizations and directions are provided by the decedent;
- (b) The person designated by the decedent as authorized to direct disposition pursuant to Pub. L. No. 109-163, s. 564, as listed on the decedent's United States Department of Defense Record of Emergency Data, DD Form 93, or its successor form, if the decedent died while in military service as described in 10 U.S.C. s. 1481(a)(1)-(8) in any branch of the United States Armed Forces, United States Reserve Forces, or National Guard;
